The *Austrian-Canadian Society* (www.austria-canada.com) is pleased to announce the call for papers for the **14th annual Scientific Award of the Austrian-Canadian Society**.

The Award will be presented to the author of the best paper, master thesis or doctoral thesis in the areas of Canadian Studies in its broad understanding, and will ideally be relevant to the study of Austria as well. The Society aims to be a key forum for bilateral exchange and cooperation, and looks to deepen the ties between Austria and Canada. The recipient of the Award will be selected by the Scientific Board of the Austrian-Canadian Society and will be announced by the Canadian Ambassador to Austria in December of this year.

The *Scientific Award of the Austrian-Canadian Society* is accompanied by a prize of € 1000,--. The winning paper or thesis will be posted on the *Austrian-Canadian Society's* website.

We seek submissions from Austrian or Canadian students at the undergraduate or graduate level, but students of other nationalities will not per se be excluded.

Ideally, papers or theses will include some comparison with/or consideration of Austrian material. They may fall into the following categories, broadly defined as:

- Law, Business and Economics**
- Political Science and Sociology**
- Culture and Media, Literature and Linguistics**
- History and Geography**
- Life Sciences and Technology**

Requirements:

Papers or theses may be written in German, French or English and should be of a minimum of 25 pages. They should not have previously been published at the time of submission. **Publication of the paper or thesis after receiving the award, however, is possible. Submissions must be received (together with an attached CV and statement that the paper or thesis has not been previously published) by Friday, November 8, 2019.** Please submit your paper or thesis electronically to the *Austrian-Canadian Society* at: secretarygeneral@austria-canada.com
