

# SUPPLEMENTARY EXAM MATHEMATICS

Starting from SS24, the supplementary exam in Mathematics consists of the following parts:

1. Mathematics 1, 1h, written exam,
2. Mathematics 2, 2h, written exam.

The supplementary exam can be passed by means of a subject-area examination following independent study. Admission to the "University course to prepare for the supplementary examinations" is mandatory.

## SUBJECT-AREA EXAMINATION FOLLOWING INDEPENDENT STUDY

Both parts of the exam are by default conducted on-site JKU. In case of failure, both parts of the exam have to be retaken.

Registration for an exam following independent study must take place at **least one week before the examination** date by sending an e-mail to the [Office of Examinations and Recognition Services, pruefung-sowi@jku.at](mailto:pruefung-sowi@jku.at) with the **admission letter** and **the JKU card attached**, and the **examiner in CC: [Jan-Michael Holzinger](mailto:Jan-Michael.Holzinger@jku.at)**.

Further information, e.g. in which rooms the examination will take place, will be communicated separately by e-mail to the applicants registered for the examination.

The exam can be taken in German or English. For the first part of the exam (Mathematics 1) using any material is disallowed. For the second part of the exam (Mathematics 2) students may use a printed version of the formula booklet/formulary "SRDP (Applied) Mathematics (AHS/BHS)", which can be obtained from the webpage <https://www.matura.gv.at/downloads/download/formelsammlung-srdp-angewandte-mathematik>, and a non-programmable calculator (e.g. TI-30X II S). It is not allowed to use other material or electronical devices during the exam.
