February 24 - March 8, 2020

The tour will take us to places of Sr. Lucy Kurien and the social organization MAHER ("Mothers' Home") for women in distress, street children, elderly people, awareness projects, village development, etc. We will draw and paint, sing, dance and live together with mentally disturbed women, orphans and elderlies at Vatsalyadham near Pune in the state of Maharashtra. We will stay at the MAHER homes at Ratnagiri and at Miraj. We will also enjoy Goa with its colonial old town and its fabled beaches. A visit of Ness Wadia College of Commerce at Pune will give us insight into one of the top 25 business schools in India. We will take India nice and slow and share Indian joy of life at markets, in villages and in many encounters with wonderful people.

Monday, Feb. 24: 5:30 departure from Café Viele Leute Pfarrplatz 4, Linz to Munich in minibus, flight Lufthansa LH 766 Munich - Mumbai (11:10 – 23:55), bus transfer to Suba Palace Hotel, overnight stay. All members of the group will be checked in electronically on the previous day.

Tuesday, Feb. 25: City tour of Mumbai (9:30 -17:00) Victoria train station, laundry services at Dhobi Ghats, Haji Ali Mosque, Gandhi Museum, lunch, Amirchand Panalalji Jain Temple, Taj Mahal Hotel; shopping in the old town, dinner, overnight at Suba Palace Hotel.

Wednesday, Feb. 26: Boat trip to Elephanta Island, visit of the temples (UNESCO World Heritage Site), lunch, in the afternoon bus trip to Miraj (240 km), overnight at MAHER children's home.

Thursday, Feb. 27: Meeting people at MAHER home at Miraj, trip to surroundings of Miraj, overnight at children's home.

Friday, Feb. 28: Bus trip to Ratnagiri (190 km), overnight at MAHER chrildren's home at Ratnagiri.

Saturday, Feb. 29: Meeting people at MAHER home at Ratnagiri, trip to Jesuit church and to beach, overnight at children's home.

Sunday, Mar. 1: Bus trip to Goa (250 km), overnight at XXX hotel.

Monday, Mar. 2: Visit of Old Goa and its Portuguese churches and buildings (UNESCO World Heritage), overnight at XXX hotel.

Tuesday, Mar. 3: visit of Old Goa and surroundings, overnight at XXX hotel.

Wednesday, Mar. 4: Flight Goa – Pune, Jet Airways 13:15 -17:15, transfer to MAHER women's and children's home at Vatsalyadham, overnight stay at Vatsalyadham.

Thursday, Mar. 5: Visit of Vatsalyadham and MAHER homes in the area, overnight at Vastsalyadham.

Friday, Mar. 6: Visit of Ness Wadia College of Commerce in Pune, meeting professors and students, at noon lunch at German Bakery, Pune market, old town, shopping, overnight at Vatsalyadham.

Saturday, Mar. 7: Visit of Karunalaya men's home and other homes in the area, art workshop with women and children, in the evening transfer to Mumbai airport

Sunday, Mar. 8: Flight Mumbai – Munich on Lufthansa LH 767 (1:25 – 5:50), bus transfer to Linz. Advance electronic check-in for all participants.

Services: all flights economy class, transportation, hotels, overnight stays at Vatsalyadham in room for several people, full board at MAHER homes. Not included are meals, if not otherwise stated, visa fee (visas will be organized by tour guide), travel insurance (recommended). Minor program changes possible.

Arrival, climate, health, currency: For entering India Austrian citizens need a passport which is still valid 3 months after planned entry into India and a visa. Currency: 1 Rupie = 100 Paise (1€ = approx. 80 Rupies). Climate: between 10° und 30°C, average 1-2 rainy days/month, no vaccinations are required in India, recommended are hepatitis A and tetanus.
